

**EYEGLOSS PRESCRIPTION FEE \$90**  
**(REFRACTION FEE)**

If you want or need a prescription for glasses, a refraction must be performed by the doctor. A refraction is the test to determine the strength of your eyeglasses.

Unfortunately at this time, many insurance companies including Medicare do NOT cover this service.

Although a few insurance plans may cover refraction, it is your responsibility to determine if your particular plan covers this service.

We will be happy to submit a claim for the refraction to your insurance company on your behalf. However if your insurance company in fact does NOT cover this benefit, you will be held responsible for the \$90.00 refraction fee.

As an alternative, you may see an optometrist to get a prescription for glasses. We can give you a referral for a local optometrist if you wish.

Please Note: This office does not fit or write prescriptions for contact lenses.
